1. PHILOSOPHY

- 1.1. The Australian Bowhunters Association Inc – Northern Territory Branch recognises the importance of health and fitness. This policy enables shooters, coaches, officials and spectators to participate in the sport of field archery in a smoke-free environment whilst on the practice or field range.

2. NON SMOKING

- 2.1 The Australian Bowhunters Association Inc – NT Branch prohibits any shooters, coaches, officials or any other person to smoke cigarettes, or any other tobacco product, on the practice or field range at events for where the Australian Bowhunters Association Inc - NT Branch is the controlling body.
- 2.2 The Australian Bowhunters Association Inc - NT Branch does not condone the smoking of cigarettes, or any other tobacco product, by any shooter, coach, official, spectator or any other person whilst on the practice or field range during an event for which the Australian Bowhunters Association Inc - NT Branch is the controlling body.
- 2.3 The Shoot Director will alert shooters to this Smoke Free Environment Policy prior to the commencement of each shoot for which the Australian Bowhunters Association Inc - NT Branch is the controlling body.

3 SMOKING AREAS

- 3.1 A designated smoking area away from food areas, and the practice and field range will be provided at each event for which the Australian Bowhunters Association Inc - NT Branch is the controlling body. The area will be well signed, and will include a receptacle for butt disposal.

4 PENALTIES

- 4.1 If any shooter, coach, official or any other person is found to be smoking cigarettes or any other tobacco product whilst on the practice or field range, the following penalties apply:
 - 4.1.1 For a first offence, the person will be given a warning.
 - 4.1.2 For a subsequent offence, the person will be escorted from the range by a Branch Official, and prohibited from completing the shoot.
